How does it work?

When? 8pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2017 Where? Radisson Blu Hotel, Rosses Point, Co. Sligo Why? To raise funds and to meet each other in a social setting!

**Cost?** €20 per person

### **How Does It Work?**

It's a Boston Tea Party ... often, two friends come together to share the job of hosting a table. One cooks a 'One-Pot-Dish' this could be a curry, chicken casserole, chilli etc. that you can serve to your table of friends and family of up to 10 or 12 people. The hotel will provide rice and baked potatoes which will be served buffet style from the middle of the room.

You can just have a main course, but most tables will have main course and dessert. So share the load! For example – let one person do the main course, another do dessert, and dips for starters or a cheese board etc.

### What happens on the night?

Doors usually open from 7.30pm, arriving at the hotel, you will be given your table number which will also be noted on your pot of food. The hotel will only keep the main course warm. When dinner is served the hotel will take your pot to your table. You will need to bring along your own serving utensils and any items you may need to help serve on the evening. The hotel will provide baked potatoes and rice; dinner and dessert plates. There will be a serving station beside your table to put dessert, home utensils etc until you're ready.

### Yes! I want to host a table, how do I get involved?

Contact details TBC. Invite your friends, work colleagues etc. Table can accommodate up to 8/10/12 people the more the merrier. Plan your meal and share the cooking. It's like attending a Dinner Party, but no need to do the dishes!

### I can't host a table but I want to go?

No problem, join in on a table within your child's class or another class. This evening is all about meeting other parents and having a social night out together.
